

Disability Access Fund (DAF)

If your child is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA) and they are accessing Early Years funding, their childcare provider can claim an extra £938 for the year.

The Disability Access Fund (DAF) is a one off payment, per child, per year paid to the provider nominated by the parent and is used to support the inclusion of eligible children from the age of 9 months to 4 years old through reasonable adjustments.
